## Northern Rivers Beef

There is a very good butchery in Wooli, next to the BP service station as you drive into Wooli were you can load up on cheap high quality Northern Rivers Beef. You will not be the first to lug an esky full of Northern Rivers Beef home with you when you leave this idyllic little seaside hamlet. You need to watch opening hours as these are erratic and change frequently so it's best to ring first.

Fresh fruit and veg is an issue and it is best to load up before you get to Wooli. There are a few roadside stalls selling a limited range of fruit and veg on the way in to Wooli so it is best to arrive prepared on the fruit and veg department.

## On The Restaurant Front

Award winning "The Gallery" Restaurant at Grafton is a fabulous culinary experience set in the court yard of the old Grafton Art Gallery.

*Harry's Chinese* Restaurant located within the Wooli Bowls Club – a 150 metre walk and is a cheap and cheer full alternative that will not disappoint.

Waves Restaurant perched on the Wooli Rivers Edge and has great views up and down the river. With superb fish and chips available in house or take way is a 350 metre walk along the river from Blue River Shack.

Wooli Hotel Restaurant - is about a 4 minute drive and provides a free mini bus service if you prefer not to drive and has a great bistro menu.
