The NSW Government announced an amnesty on recreational fishing restrictions from ocean beaches and headlands in sanctuaries on 12 March 2013.

- Recreational line fishing ONLY from mainland ocean beaches and headlands in sanctuary zones under the amnesty
- All other restrictions continue to apply
- The amnesty does not apply to estuaries, embayments, or islands
- The amnesty does not apply to:
 - commercial fishing,
 - o spearfishing
 - o fishing from a boat or vessel
 - o collecting

North Solitary Island

- lobster or abalone fishing
- Arrawarra Headland special purpose zone: any form of fishing and collecting NOT PERMITTED
- Fisheries NSW bag and size limits still apply
- All other Marine Park and Fisheries regulations still apply
- Regulations for dogs and vehicles on beaches have not changed and continue to apply


